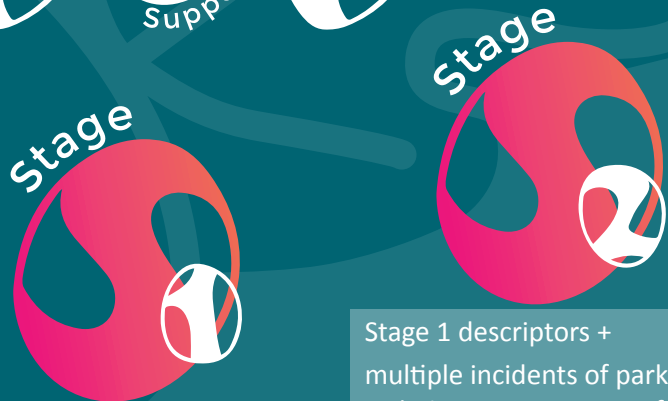


PASTORAL SUPPORT PLAN (PSP)

A **Pastoral Support** plan (PSP) will be implemented for students whose behaviour continues to cause concern. This will be managed by the students' Pastoral Manager and supported by the wider Pastoral Team. The plan is staged 1-5, when targets are achieved students move to a lower stage and eventually rewarded by being removed from the plan. If targets are not achieved sanctions and support may escalate to the next stage.



Stage 1 descriptors + multiple incidents of parking, Isolation or persistent refusal to comply with sanctions and support
